

Announcements made on Sunday 20th February 2022: Covid-19 Restrictions

After broad discussion and consideration of the Government changes, together with the information circulated by PCI, our Session agreed the following changes which will commence from Sunday 27th February:

Social distancing:

The need for social distancing within the pews is no longer required for most of the church areas. The tape will be removed from the pews, except for the shorter pews along the North Street side of church and the North Street transept. Social distancing will remain in this designated area to provide any members of the congregation who would like to continue to do so, to sit in a socially distanced manner.

Face Masks: we would encourage you to continue to wear a face mask when coming into and leaving the building. However, whilst seated in the pew, and also in the Welcome area, each individual can decide whether to wear a face mask or not, and this would include for singing.

Hand sanitiser: we will continue to make hand sanitiser available at all entrances and we would encourage you to sanitise your hands as you come in.

Other factors: It was agreed that the one-way system will be removed, so church can be accessed from the front through the Vestibule and from the Welcome Area.
